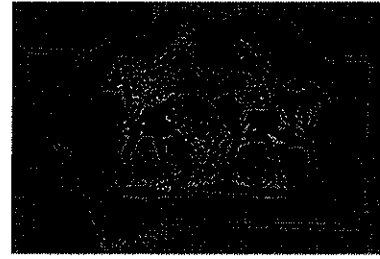

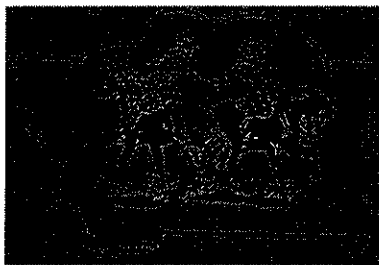

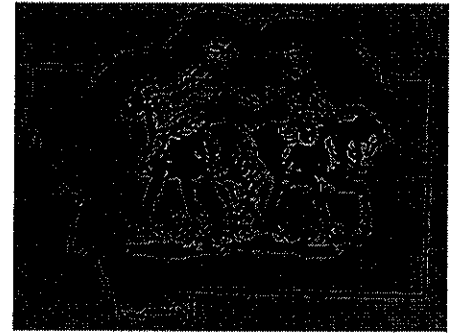

## ROYALTY JUDGE(S)

Per the Montana Saddle Club Association rule book each district or saddle club is to send in a royalty judge volunteer. Below is a list of what will be required of this person to look for from the royalty contestants over the weekend. Seven judges will be randomly selected (names out of a hat) from the pool of volunteers to judge the contest. Each judge will receive a judging packet from the royalty coordinator with score sheets on each contestant.. All judges will remain anonymous.

1. Royalty contest will be judged as follows;

Personality	20%
Overall Conduct and working in arena	20%
Appearance of Rider	20%
Care of horse and Stall	10%
Horsemanship pattern	20%
Public Speaking	10%

2. Each contestant will be issued an official number identifying their age group by color. Numbers are to be worn at all times while on the show grounds.
3. Attendance at the Royalty meeting (Friday prior to the contestants meeting approximately 6:30), Contestants meeting (Friday at 7:00pm), Grand Entry (Saturday and Sunday) and Awards (Sunday) is mandatory. Unless excused with a doctor or veterinarian note.
4. Western equipment and attire is recommended for all contestants while they are on the show grounds.
5. Hats and ties are optional, except during preliminaries, introductions, grand entry, awards, or any judged activity. Safety helmets can be used in substitution while on horseback with no penalty.
6. Formal western attire can be used during all meetings and special occasions.
7. Contestants should be prepared to answer questions on horsemanship, horses, the MSCA history and show, etc.
8. All contestants are required to assist with fundraising events at state including but not limited to, barrel race on Friday night (raking, setting barrels, running the gate, etc.), selling 50/50 tickets throughout the weekend and assisting in collecting monies, judging and participating in the "Tough Enough to Wear Pink" or other similar contests. *If you are unable to attend fundraising events of Friday, please notify coordinator and alternate arrangements can be made.*
9. Contestants are encouraged to decorate your horses' stalls or pens.

## MSCA Royalty Contest

### Regulations and Guidelines

1. This shall be a regular event at the MSCA Championship show.
2. Royalty contestants must meet all requirements governing all contestants in the MSCA championship show.
3. Age division shall be as follows: Queen 16-20; Sr. Princess 12-15, Jr. Princess Under 12, age as of January 1<sup>st</sup> determines age division.
4. All royalty contestants must be single (never married).
5. Entry fee will be \$5.00 per contestant.
6. A 4X6 photo will be submitted with the contestant form. The photo will **NOT** be returned.
7. Royalty contestants must ride a minimum of the 5 o-mok-see "basic" timed event in addition to the Royalty contest.
8. Royalty contestants may not succeed themselves in the same age division.
9. All contestants must report to the Royalty Coordinator prior to the show. Royalty packets will be picked up the Royalty meeting Friday.
10. Each contestant will be issued an official number identifying their age group by color. Numbers are to be worn at all times while on the show grounds.
11. Attendance at the Royalty meeting (Friday prior to the contestants meeting approximately 6:30), Contestants meeting (Friday at 7:00pm), Grand Entry (Saturday and Sunday) and Awards (Sunday) is mandatory. Unless excused with a doctor or veterinarian note.
12. Western equipment and attire is recommended for all contestants while they are on the show grounds.
13. Hats and ties are optional, except during preliminaries, introductions, grand entry, awards, or any judged activity. Safety helmets can be used in substitution while on horseback with no penalty.
14. Formal western attire can be used during all meetings and special occasions.
15. Contestants should be prepared to answer questions on horsemanship, horses, the MSCA history and show, etc
16. MSCA Royalty shall reign for one year and will be crowned by the previous year's royalty, if present.
17. Judges will be chosen from a pool of judges submitted by each club or district. Royalty Coordinator will make every attempt to have judges from different clubs to represent the MSCA as a whole.
18. Point sheets will be checked by the Royalty Coordinator and 2 Officers or individuals appointed by the MSCA President for verification.
19. Awards for the winner and first runner up in each age category will be given if there are sufficient contestants. Incoming royalty will receive a Tierra or Belt buckle, sash and award equal to timed event winners, 1<sup>st</sup> Runner up will receive award equal to timed event reserve winner. All other awards will be left to the discretion of the Royalty Coordination who will notify all contestants of additional awards prior to formal judging.

20. Royalty contestants point sheets and forms must be mailed to all contestants within 30 days after the show.
21. Good sportsmanship at ALL times is mandatory. See MSCA rule book for Sportsmanship outline.
22. Royalty contest will be judged as follows;

Personality	20%
Overall Conduct and working in arena	20%
Appearance of Rider	20%
Care of horse and Stall	10%
Horsemanship pattern	20%
Public Speaking	10%

#### Duties of MSCA Reigning Royalty

1. Reigning royalty shall make every effort to attend the State Convention, Spring Board meeting, and the next MSCA State Championship.
2. Reigning royalty shall ride in at least one parade as an MSCA representative.
3. Perform at least 5 hours of community service as an MSCA representative. This may include anything that exposes the public to the sport of O-Mok-See and could entail speaking at local grade schools, local radio programs or state/county fairs, etc.
4. Reigning royalty shall perform fund raising for the royalty and MSCA programs.
5. Reigning royalty should keep a record of their activities as the MSCA representative, and be prepared to report this to the general meeting of the convention and at the following state show as directed by the Royalty Coordinator.

#### Duties of all Reining Royalty and Royalty Contestants at state finals.

1. All contestants are required to provide/donate a minimum of 3 items for the silent auction at the state finals.
2. All contestants are required to assist with fundraising events at state including but not limited to, barrel race on Friday night (raking, setting barrels, running the gate, etc.), selling 50/50 tickets throughout the weekend and assisting in collecting monies, judging and participating in the "Tough Enough to Wear Pink" or other similar contests. *If you are unable to attend fundraising events of Friday, please notify coordinator and alternate arrangements can be made.*
3. Contestants are encouraged to decorate your horses' stalls or pens.
